## **Mission Control – Read (non-negotiable)**

Read for 10 minutes everyday with an adult.

## **Number Facts** **(non-negotiable)**

Practise counting on and back and number bonds- this can be in the car, on a walk, while brushing your teeth. Know them off by heart.

## **Mission 1 – Investigate**

Find out something you didn't know about our current topic. Visit the class page to look at the knowledge organisers. You could present this in a quiz, wordsearch, a booklet, poster, the options are endless!

## **Mission 2 – Real Life Maths**

Find a maths problem in everyday life and work it out. Practise telling the time on an analogue clock and recognising different coins and notes. Visit Numbots too.

## **Mission 3 – Think**

Discuss this term's big question with someone at home.

## **Mission 4 – Create**

Show something you have learned in a creative way. Build it, act it, sing/rap it, paint it, draw it. We'd love to see how you have been inspired.
